

DESIGNATION AS AN IMPAIRED INSURER UNDER
TEXAS INSURANCE CODE CHAPTER 462


General remarks and official action taken:

The commissioner of insurance considers the matter of Santa Fe Auto Insurance Company, organized under the laws of the State of Texas, doing the business of insurance in the State of Texas. On April 5, 2013, the 419th District Court of Travis County, Texas entered an Order Appointing Liquidator and Permanent Injunction in Cause No. D-1-GV-13-000204, finding Santa Fe Auto Insurance Company to be insolvent.

Based on the finding of insolvency by the Court, and having considered the purposes of TEX. INS. CODE ANN. Chapter 462, the commissioner designates Santa Fe Auto Insurance Company an "impaired insurer" as that term is defined in TEX. INS. CODE ANN. § 462.004 (5), effective April 5, 2013.
