
DESIGNATION AS AN IMPAIRED INSURER UNDER
TEXAS INSURANCE CODE ARTICLE 21.28-C

General remarks and official action taken:

On this day came on for consideration by the Commissioner of Insurance the matter of Realm National Insurance Company, organized under the laws of the State of New York, and doing the business of insurance in the State of Texas. On June 15, 2005, the Supreme Court of the State of New York entered an Order of Liquidation in Cause No. 401876/05, finding Realm National Insurance Company to be insolvent.

Based upon the finding of insolvency by the Supreme Court of the State of New York, and having considered the purposes of TEX. INS. CODE ANN. art. 21.28-C, the Commissioner of Insurance finds that Realm National Insurance Company should be, and is hereby, designated as an impaired insurer as that term is defined in TEX. INS. CODE ANN. art. 21.28-C §5(9), effective June 15, 2005.
