
FRONTIER INSURANCE COMPANY  
DESIGNATION AS AN IMPAIRED INSURER  
UNDER TEXAS INSURANCE CODE CHAPTER 462

General remarks and official action taken:

The commissioner of insurance considered the matter of Frontier Insurance Company ("Frontier"), an insurance company organized under the laws of New York that was licensed to engage in the business of insurance in Texas. On November 16, 2012, the Supreme Court of the State of New York entered a Liquidation Order against Frontier, finding Frontier to be insolvent.

Based on these facts, the commissioner orders that Frontier is designated as an "impaired insurer" as defined in TEX. INS. CODE ANN. § 462.004 (5), effective November 16, 2012.
